



What are my college options ...without a Core 40 diploma?

Ball State University

Campus in Muncie, Indiana

You can apply if you earn a general diploma or a GED.

Indiana University

Campuses in Bloomington, Fort Wayne, Gary, Indianapolis, Kokomo, New Albany, Richmond, and South Bend

You can apply if you earn a general diploma but you must participate in the Summer Success Academy

You can apply if you earn a GED, but you must earn an average score of at least 530 and earn 500 or higher on the writing section.

Ivy Tech Community College

Campuses in Anderson, Batesville, Bloomington, Columbus, Connersville, Crawfordsville, East Chicago, Elkhart, Evansville, Fort Wayne, Franklin, Gary, Greencastle, Indianapolis, Kokomo, Lafayette, Lawrenceburg, Logansport, Madison, Marion, Michigan City, Muncie, New Castle, Richmond, Sellersburg, South Bend, Tell City, Terre Haute, Valparaiso, Wabash, and Warsaw

You can apply if you earn a general diploma, a GED, a certificate of completion, or no diploma.

Purdue University

Campuses in Fort Wayne, Hammond, Indianapolis, West Lafayette, and Westville

You can apply if you earn a general diploma or a GED.

Vincennes University

Campuses in Jasper and Vincennes

You can apply if you earn a general diploma or a GED.
